Shin-Go-Beek Campout
January 27-29

We are set to go to Shin-Go-Beek January 27-29. This has always been a popular campout. Please think about helping out by driving. It will be cold and there may be snow. Boys need to be prepared. In addition to regular camping gear the following is needed:

- Spare clothing, especially socks, and boots to keep dry
- Extra warm gloves, hat, boots
- Money for two meals, one up and one back

We are planning to depart from First United Church at 4:30 PM on Friday, January 27.

Note that this is much earlier than our usual departure time. It is possible that some cars may leave later, once we know who is going and who is driving. Return should be about 3:00 PM Sunday, January 29.

Fees are as follows: \$35 per scout and \$25 for adults driving, to cover food costs, bowling and Saturday dinner (pizza) at a restaurant. **The signup deadline is Friday, January 20..**

We are, of course, tent camping. Hopefully there will be snow. Scouts have sometimes built an igloo or two to sleep in, go sledding or snowboarding, hike on the lake, cross-country ski. The troop will bring cross country skis and snowshoes.

Keep in mind that to attend this campout, the scout must have sold at least 15 wreaths. It is up to the scout to have his receipts in to Mr. Tresselt by January 13 to support his eligibility.
